

## COMMUNITY HOUSING ADVISORY BOARD

### **MANDATE:**

The Community Housing Advisory Board acts as an advisor to Council on affordable housing, homelessness, services/activities related to the goal to end homelessness, and funding allocation within Red Deer.

**TERMS OF OFFICE:** Staggered – two year term

### **MEMBERSHIP:**

Six citizen representatives, two representatives from the Aboriginal Community and one Council representative

The Community Housing Advisory Board shall make its decisions by Consensus.

**MEETING TIMES:** The fourth Tuesday of the month at 5:00 p.m. Time commitment is approximately 2 - 4 hours per month

**REMUNERATION:** None

**TRAINING:** One hour orientation session for new members
