

**RED DEER SUBDIVISION & DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD/
RED DEER APPEAL & REVIEW BOARD**

MANDATE:

The Red Deer Subdivision & Development Appeal Board (SDAB) hears appeals from people who have been affected by a decision of the Development Authority and/or the Subdivision authority under the Land Use Bylaw. SDABs are under the jurisdiction of the Municipal Government Act (MGA) and the Subdivision and Development Regulation, as well as the City of Red Deer Land Use Bylaw and related planning guides.

The Red Deer Appeal & Review Board hears appeals related to some of the bylaws created by The City of Red Deer.

Appointments are made jointly to the Red Deer Appeal & Review Board (RDARB) and the Red Deer Subdivision and Development Appeal Board.

TERM OF OFFICE: Staggered - two year term

MEMBERSHIP: Five citizen representatives, one being an alternate, and one Council representative, and one alternate Council representative.

MEETING TIMES: Dates/times varied - based on number of appeals. Meetings typically start at 5:00 p.m.

REMUNERATION: Honorarium

TRAINING: Orientation session for new members
