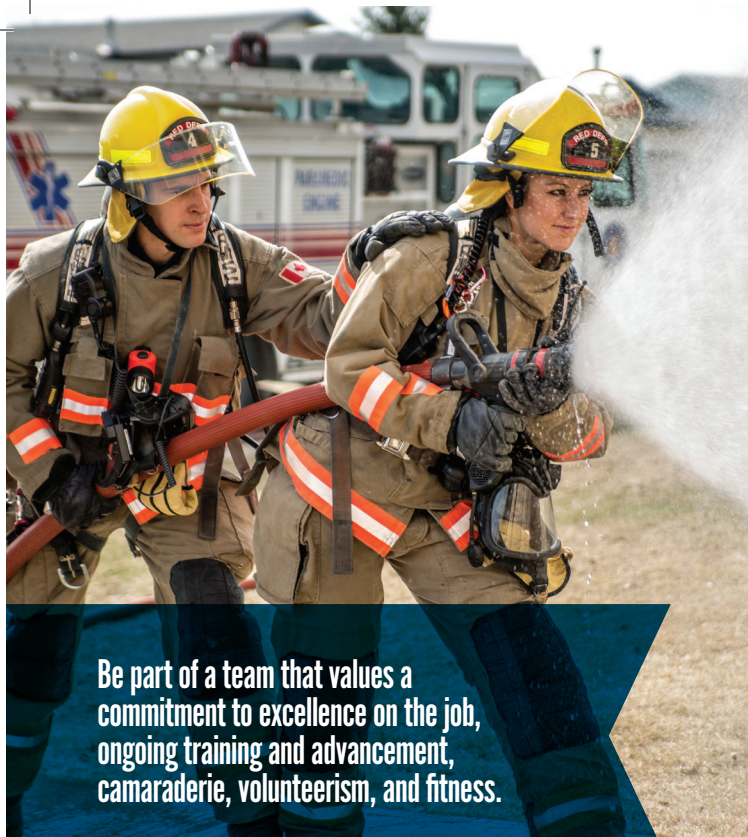
THE COMMUNITY OF RED DEER

Because Red Deer offers a combined fire, rescue and Advanced Life Support ambulance service, there are a number of opportunities throughout your career to develop your skills.

As part of our commitment to serving the community in all emergency situations, Red Deer Emergency Services offers training in several areas including vehicle extrication, high angle rope rescue, river and ice rescue, hazardous material response, and fire prevention and public education. EMS AND FIREFIGHTING

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and firefighting are challenging fields in their own right, but combine the two and you have an extraordinarily dynamic and rewarding career. Build that career with The City of Red Deer! We field a team of FireMedics who practice both EMS and firefighting, so that we can provide comprehensive Emergency Services to our community. All new employees must first be registered practitioners with the Alberta College of Paramedics, then are cross-trained as firefighters. We require applicants to have a minimum of training at the EMT-A level, but preference is given to candidates with EMT-P level training as well as fire training..

HEALTH & FITNESS

Want to get paid to work out? FireMedics are not only encouraged to stay fit – it's built into the workday. We put a huge emphasis on health and fitness at Red Deer Emergency Services by requiring members to work out while on shift, so we've installed a workout facility in every station. Staff also receive discounted memberships to other City recreational facilities.
