Land Use Bylaw Amendment 3357/C-2016

Red Deer City Council is considering amending the Land Use Bylaw to amend the Industrial Support Service definition to include Information Technology Support, Financial Services, and other uses whose principle use is to provide services to industrial clients, as determined by the Development Authority.

City Council will hear from any person claiming to be affected by the proposed bylaws at the Public Hearing on **Tuesday, February 16, 2016** at 6:00 p.m. in Council Chambers, 2nd Floor of City Hall. If you want your letter included in the Council agenda you must submit it to the Manager, Legislative Services by **Friday, February 5, 2016**. You may also submit your letter at the Public Hearing, or you can simply tell Council your views at the Public Hearing. Council's Procedure Bylaw indicates that each presentation is limited to 10 minutes. Any submission will be public information.
