RED DEER SUBDIVISION & DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD / RED DEER APPEAL & REVIEW BOARD (joint appointment)

MANDATE:

The Red Deer Subdivision & Development Appeal Board (SDAB) is responsible to hear and make decisions on appeals from people who have been affected by a decision of the Development Authority and/or the Subdivision Authority under the Land Use Bylaw. SDABs are under the jurisdiction of the Municipal Government Act (MGA) and the Subdivision and Development Regulation, as well as the City of Red Deer Land Use Bylaw and related planning guides.

The Red Deer Appeal & Review Board is responsible to hear and makes decisions on appeals related to some of the bylaws created by The City of Red Deer

Appointments are made jointly to the Red Deer Appeal & Review Board (RDARB) and the Red Deer Subdivision and Development Appeal Board.
