



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: Children are our most important resource, and it is our collective responsibility to care for and protect them;

WHEREAS: Statistics indicate that individuals with Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) in Canada and other industrial nations face the risk of developmental delays, learning disabilities, early school drop-out, homelessness, addiction issues, trouble with the law and mental illness; and

WHEREAS: Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders are preventable and, to reduce the incidence of FASD, it is essential that women in pregnancy are provided with support and information; and

WHEREAS: September 9th, 2025 is recognized as the 25th "International Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder Awareness Day" in Red Deer by the "Central Alberta Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder Network".

NOW THEREFORE,

I, Ken Johnston, Mayor of the City of Red Deer, hereby proclaim September 9, 2025, International Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder Awareness Day" in Red Deer. I encourage Red Deerians to take the opportunity to act with understanding towards those individuals and their loved ones whose lives have been affected by prenatal exposure to alcohol and to help raise awareness for FASD prevention.
