

## **Community Recreation Enhancement Grant**

### **1. What is the Community Recreation Enhancement Grant (CREG) program?**

The City of Red Deer recognizes the important contribution made by non-profit recreation organizations in the provision of recreation opportunities and events. This grant program is designed to support these organizations to support and enhance their ability to deliver recreation services and programs to Red Deer residents. For the purpose of this grant, the term “recreation” includes sport, fitness, play, activity and outdoor pursuits.

### **2. Who is eligible for the program?**

To apply, applicants must be a registered non-profit organization in good standing and meet the following requirements:

- Contribute to at least one of the nine community goals as listed in the Social Policy Framework (see Section C of Application Guide)
- Demonstrate that at least 50% of those directly benefiting from the project are Red Deer residents.
- Agree to report on positive enhancements or identifiable improvements that occur due to the grant funding as required.

Eligible applicants may submit more than one application per deadline date.

### **3. How can I apply?**

Applications will be received two times per year. Completed applications must be submitted prior to the deadlines of April 3 or October 2 of the funding year.

### **4. How much funding is available within the Community Recreation Enhancement Grant program?**

A total of approximately \$100,000 is available through this grant program each funding year. A maximum of \$5,000 will be awarded to each successful applicant.
