## Bylaw 3357/J-2019 Land Use Bylaw Amendment

Red Deer City Council is considering an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to redesignate 22 Gunn Street from the A1 Future Urban Development District to the R1 Residential (Low Density) and R1G Residential (Small Lot) Districts.
