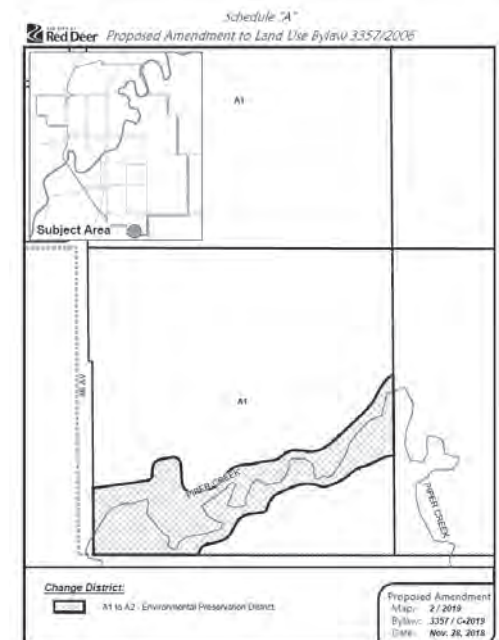
Land Use Bylaw Amendment
