Development Officer Approvals

On August 27, 2019, the Development Officer issued approvals for the following applications:

Permitted Use

Eastview Estates

1. Shoaf, R. & Eguia, B. – a 24.41 m² variance to the Maximum Site Coverage, for a proposed 15.8 m² addition (enclosed deck and breezeway) to an existing Detached Dwelling, to be located at 26 Eline Street.

2. Patzer, R. – a 1.4 m variance to the Minimum Rear Yard, from the doors to the lane, for a proposed Accessory Building (detached garage), to be located at 11 Jepsen Crescent.

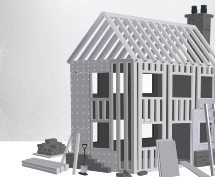
Discretionary Use

A Permitted Use decision may not be appealed unless it involves a variation or misinterpretation of the Land Use Bylaw. Appeal forms (outlining appeal fees) are available at Legislative Services.
