## Development Officer Approvals

On March 19, 2019, the Development Officer issued approvals for the following applications:

### Permitted Use

#### Inglewood

1. Heintz, D. & M. – a 1.69 m variance to the Minimum Rear Yard, to an existing deck, located at 58 Ivany Close.

#### Timberstone

2. Laebon Developments Ltd. – a 0.17 m variance to the Minimum Rear Yard and a 2.51 m<sup>2</sup> variance to the Minimum Front Yard Landscaped Area, for a proposed Detached Dwelling, to be located at 45 Terra Close.

### Discretionary Use

#### Gaetz Lakes

3. Waskasoo Environmental Education Society – a Temporary Building (tent), to be located at 6300 45 Avenue.

### Oriole Park

4. Didychuk, K. – a two-bedroom Secondary Suite, to be located at 10 Oreston Close.

A Discretionary Use decision may be appealed to the Red Deer Subdivision & Development Appeal Board, Legislative Services, City Hall, **prior to 4:30 p.m. on April 9, 2019**. A Permitted Use decision may not be appealed unless it involves a variation or misinterpretation of the Land Use Bylaw. Appeal forms (outlining appeal fees) are available at Legislative Services. ## Bylaw 3357/H-2019 Land Use Bylaw Amendment

Red Deer City Council is considering an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to redistrict 4028-51 Street (Lots 29-32, Block 9, Plan 3586AE) from R1 Residential (Low Density) District to R2 Residential (Medium Density) District.

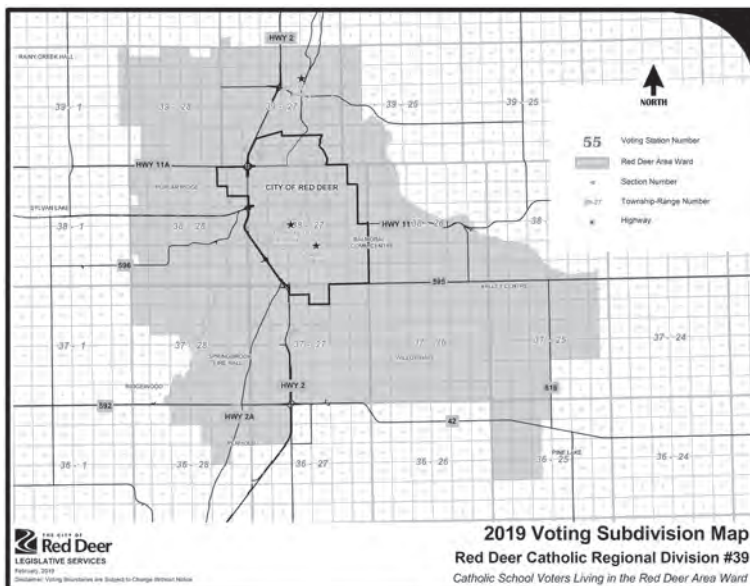

#### ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE:

1. A list of voters is not prepared.
2. Every voter shall make a statement in the prescribed form that he/she is eligible to vote as an elector.
3. A person is eligible to vote if the person:
  - (a) is at least 18 years old,
  - (b) is a Canadian Citizen, and
  - (c) resides in Alberta and the person's place of residence is located in the Red Deer Catholic Regional Division #39 – Red Deer Area Ward on election day.
4. With regard to the election of Separate School Trustees an elector is an individual residing within the boundaries of the separate school district who is of the same faith as those who established the district.

#### VOTER IDENTIFICATION:

You are required to **complete the oval** beside the name of the person for whom you wish to vote.
