WATER CONSERVATION GUIDELINES

The guidelines will be in effect from **May 1 to October 1** every year to help us conserve water during warm months. Four separate stages range in severity depending on current conditions.

VOLUNTARY

STAGE 1

Careful water use

Conditions are normal; try to conserve

ENFORCED

STAGE 2

Reduce water use

Red Deer River flow is slower than normal

STAGE 3

Reduce non-essential water use

Red Deer River flow is low, dry conditions

STAGE 4

Stop non-essential water use

Emergency water shortage

STAGE 1

on odd days
as needed



Even-numbered
address, water
on even days
as needed



WHEN WASHING YOUR VEHICLE



Wash at a drive-thru car wash:
water can be recirculated to conserve!

WHEN WASHING OUTDOOR SURFACES



Think before you wash:
only wash for
dust control or
safety concerns



Use a commercial
cleaning service or
wash by hand to
reduce water waste

Stages 2, 3 or 4 could be put in effect if the
Red Deer River flow is very low,
or if conditions are very dry.
